Arizona COVID-19 cases

The Arizona Department of Health Services has reported 227,635 positive COVID-19 cases and 147,551 cases in Maricopa County as of Oct. 14, 2020. Out of the 1,893,077 COVID-19 tests completed to date in Arizona, 10.0% have tested positive for the virus. Percent positive is the number of people with a positive test result, out of all the people COVID-19 tested completed in Arizona.

In Maricopa County, 12,738 patients (9%) have been admitted to a hospital and 1,412 (1%) admitted to an ICU since the county began collecting data on Jan. 22.

COVID-19 update

Since our peak in July and August, we've seen a decline in COVID-90 patients across the Abrazo Market and across the State of Arizona. This has been a welcome relief. However, ADHS data shows an increase in new cases reported across the state. We are continuing to watch these numbers daily – both in our hospitals and across the state – to look for any trends that may be appearing. Thank you for all that you do to keep our patients, and each other, safe.

PTO transition update

We are excited to share an update to the PTO transition. Please contact a member of the HR team know if you have any questions.

The pandemic has proved to be challenging in different ways, one of which is it hasn't allowed some of you to take the personal time off (PTO) that you have accrued throughout the year. We have received concerns with the current deadline of using PTO "new hours" by the end of the year and as we take your feedback seriously have modified our policy transition approach. Listed below is the relevant policy update, with all other PTO policy changes communicated in February remaining unchanged:

- **Deadline to use PTO "new hours."** We will extend the deadline to use PTO "new hours" (hours accrued after February 1, 2020) from December 31, 2020 through September 30, 2021. This provides you with an additional nine months to use any time accrued, but unused this year. The expiration date for use of PTO "old hours" (hours accrued prior to February 1, 2020) remains unchanged through June 30, 2022. There will not be any further extensions to the deadlines.
- **"Special" sell back event.** We have decided to hold an additional "special" sell back event in November where employees can sell up to one week of their PTO "old hours". To encourage participation, we have increased the sell back value from 50% to 75% for this "special" sell back event only.

We appreciate the feedback received and hope the above actions provide additional support in using your PTO. Thank you again for your hard work during the pandemic and every day as you serve our patients.
