#### Arizona COVID-19 cases

The Arizona Department of Health Services has reported 195,557 positive COVID-19 cases and 130,384 cases in Maricopa County as of Aug. 19, 2020. Out of the 1,363,786 COVID-19 tests completed to date in Arizona, 12.0% have tested positive for the virus. Percent positive is the number of people with a positive test result, out of all the people COVID-19 tested completed in Arizona.

In Maricopa County, 14,068 patients (11%) have been admitted to a hospital and 1,156 (1%) admitted to an ICU since the county began collecting data on Jan. 22. People aged 65 or older or those who have at least one chronic health condition make up 42% of those who have been hospitalized and 82% of deaths for COVID-19. Approximately 63% of all COVID-19 infections reported have been among those under 45 years old.

#### New GME residencies start at Abrazo West

Abrazo West Campus has launched two new graduate medical residency programs – one in emergency medicine and the other a transitional year program. The new residencies began July 1.

Residents in the three-year emergency medicine program will primarily gain experience in Abrazo West's Level 1 trauma center, with additional rotations in the ED at the Arrowhead Campus. They will also do cardiology rotations at Abrazo Arizona Heart Hospital and in pediatrics at Phoenix Children's Hospital. Six residents will be admitted every year, for a total of 18 over three years.

The transitional year program is one of only two in the Phoenix area. The one-year program accepts 13 residents per year, providing clinical experience and education in multiple disciplines to help prepare residents for a specific specialty. Many specialties require one year of general medical experience in such areas as internal medicine, general surgery, outpatient medicine and emergency medicine before residents go into their chosen specialty.

Abrazo now offers five Graduate Medical Education programs. In 2019, Abrazo launched residencies in internal medicine and general surgery, based at the Arrowhead Campus. Abrazo has offered its family medicine residency program since 1978 at Abrazo Central Campus.
