Arizona COVID-19 cases

The Arizona Department of Health Services has reported 180,505 positive COVID-19 cases and 121,789 cases in Maricopa County as of Aug. 4, 2020. Out of the 1,112,825 COVID-19 tests completed to date in Arizona, 12.6% have tested positive for the virus. Percent positive is the number of people with a positive test result, out of all the people COVID-19 tested completed in Arizona.

In Maricopa County, 8,929 patients (7%) have been admitted to a hospital and 1,001 (1%) admitted to an ICU since the county began collecting data on Jan. 22. People aged 65 or older or those who have at least one chronic health condition make up 50% of those who have been hospitalized and 84% of deaths for COVID-19. Approximately 62% of all COVID-19 infections reported have been among those under 45 years old.
