Arizona COVID-19 cases

The Arizona Department of Health Services has reported 206,541 positive COVID-19 cases and 135,324 cases in Maricopa County as of Sept. 9, 2020. Out of the 1,541,471 COVID-19 tests completed to date in Arizona, 11.2% have tested positive for the virus. Percent positive is the number of people with a positive test result, out of all the people COVID-19 tested completed in Arizona.

In Maricopa County, 14,214 patients (10%) have been admitted to a hospital and 1,295 (1%) admitted to an ICU since the county began collecting data on Jan. 22.
