What are biosimilar products?

- The FDA defines biosimilar products as *a biological product that is highly similar to, and has no clinically meaningful differences, in terms of safety or effectiveness from an existing FDA-licensed reference product.*
- Products considered biosimilar to Humira include: **Hyrimoz, Idacio, and Yusimry.**

What are interchangeable products?

- The FDA defines an interchangeable product as *a biological product that meets the requirements for a biosimilar product and is approved based on information that is sufficient to show that it can be expected to produce the same clinical result as the reference product in any given patient.*
- Interchangeable products for Humira include:
 - **Abrilada**
 - **Amjevita**
 - **Cyltezo**
 - **Hadlima**
 - **Hulio**
 - **Hyrimoz**
 - **Simlandi**
 - **Yuflyma**

These products can be substituted without prescriber intervention.

Why choose a Biosimilar?

- Humira has the highest average cost per prescription at \$31,098.86. All interchangeable products range from \$11,081.10 on average for Amjevita, to \$90.59 for Yuflyma.
