Understanding Your Benefits

Connected Care ACN is a preferred provider network that works in the following ways:

- You receive the highest level of coverage at the lowest cost from your medical home, which includes your primary care provider and medical care team
- Your medical neighborhood includes other providers and resources such as specialists, hospitals, imaging and lab facilities
- To ensure in-network benefits, you are responsible for confirming all your providers (specialists, hospitals, imaging, labs, etc.) are in-network
- Some members may choose to pay more to use out-of-network providers

Out of Area Coverage

When you or covered family members seek routine or emergency care outside your home service area, you can still take advantage of member benefits by seeing anyone listed in the national network of providers. Why Select a PCP?

Your PCP is a personal health advocate who will:

- Manage your routine medical needs
- Coordinate referrals to a specialist, if needed
- Refer you for lab, imaging or hospital services

Office Visits vs. Preventive Visits

An office visit is a problem-focused appointment designed to address new or existing health issues. Office visits are covered at the standard benefit level resulting in coinsurance and/or deductible being applied. Virtual or telehealth visits may also be an option and are covered under your plan.

A preventive visit is a yearly appointment (either an annual physical or a well-child exam) intended to prevent illness and detect health concerns early—before symptoms are noticeable. You will receive 100% preventive care coverage.
